GREAT MISSENDEN PARISH REVITALISATION GROUP CONSTITUTION

1. NAME

The group shall be called The Great Missenden Parish Revitalisation Group – hereinafter referred to as “The Group”.

2. AIMS

The Group will act as a forum for the consideration, co –ordination of revitalisation initiatives proposed for the social, economic and or environmental benefit of Great Missenden Parish -

- a) by liaising through members of the Group with the interests they represent
- b) by acting as a link with other similar groups or associations
- c) by representing local views and opinion on revitalisation matters to the appropriate local authorities and agencies.

3. MEMBERSHIP

The Group will include representatives from no less than 3 village societies, organisations and or associations, and may include the Parish Council, Chiltern District Council and Bucks County Council.

The Group will have the power to co-opt additional members whenever deemed appropriate.

4. MANAGEMENT

The management of business shall be conducted on behalf of the group by the three officers, namely Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer. These shall be appointed at an annual general meeting.

5. FINANCE

The Group shall open a bank account. The Treasurer shall present a report at each meeting of the Group. Cheques shall be signed by the Treasurer and one other officer of the Group.

The Treasurer shall prepare annually for inspection the accounts for the previous twelve months, and these shall be inspected by a suitably qualified person.

6. MEETINGS

There will be a minimum of 3 meetings per year but will be held as considered necessary.

There shall be an Annual General Meeting which shall be held in the month of in each year or as soon as practicable thereafter. It may be necessary to arrange extraordinary meetings.

7. DISSOLUTION

Such a decision would have to be agreed by a clear majority of members of the Group. In such an event any assets shall be disposed of to a group with similar aims and objectives which shall benefit the parish of Great Missenden or returned to the donors.
